

IRS Forms 1095-C (Employer-Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage) and 1095-B (Health Coverage)

The Florida Division of State Group Insurance (DSGI), has begun distributing IRS Form 1095-C to all current and former employees who were enrolled in health insurance plans at any time in the 2016 calendar year. Form 1095-C provides information about the months that employees and their eligible spouses and dependents, if any, had health insurance coverage through the State of Florida. **Please note that Form 1095-C is strictly informational. Employees do not need to attach it to their 2016 tax return and should be able to complete their tax return without the form. DSGI advises all employees to simply keep a copy of this form for their records.**

Employees who opted to receive their 1095-C forms electronically will receive an email notification from People First when their form is available. Those who did not opt-in will receive their forms by mail. DSGI expects that all forms will be mailed and/or available electronically by February 18, 2017.

Additionally, employees who had coverage with Capital Health Plan (CHP) in 2016 will receive form 1095-B by mail. This form is also provided for informational purposes and does not need to be attached to your 2016 tax return.
